


M'NAIR PAYS VISIT TO CAMP



Lt. Gen. Lesley J. McNair, above, commanding general of the Army Ground forces and one of the Army's highest ranking officers, paid a brief visit to Camp Atterbury Friday afternoon, landing by plane at Atterbury Army Air field here.

The Camp Atterbury public relations office stated that General McNair, who has headquarters in Washington, D. C., was on a routine tour of inspection.

General McNair was greeted at the local airfield by Brig. Gen. Herbert P. Perrin, assistant commander of the 106th Division at Atterbury; Col. Richardson L. Greene, commanding officer of the Eighth Detachment of Special Troops, Second army, stationed at Atterbury; Col. Welton M. Modisette, Atterbury commander, and Capt. George B. Ober, commanding officer of the Air field.

General McNair was at Atterbury about one and one-half hours. He was accompanied by a number of staff officers. The Army Ground forces commander was commander of R. O. T. C. at Purdue university from 1924 to 1928.
