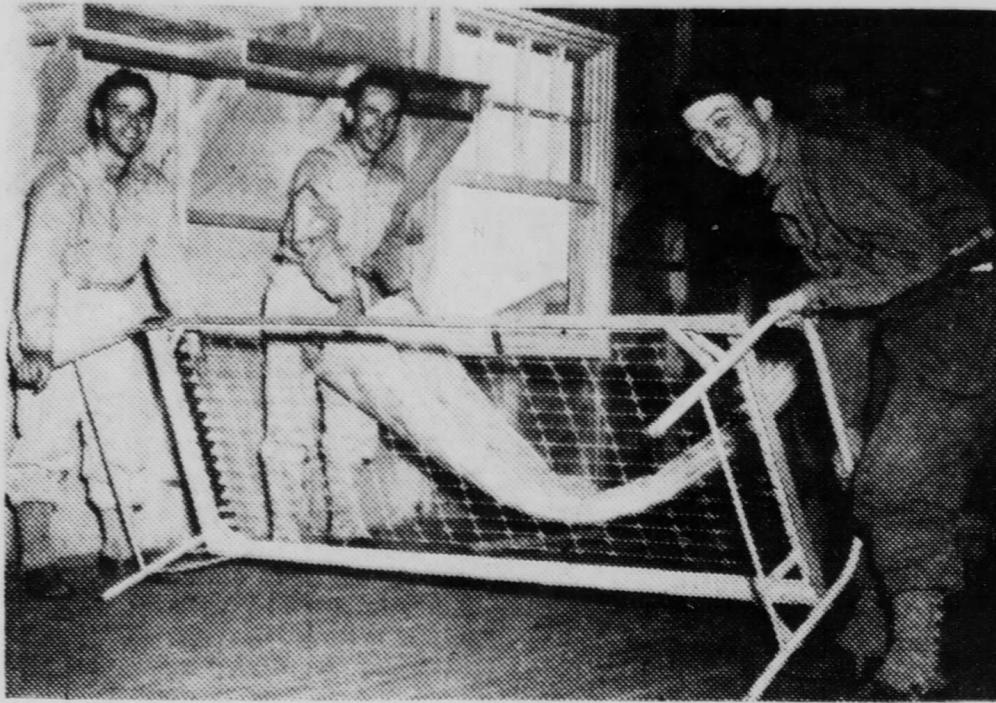


## Strange Indeed—Smiles on Moving Day
