

## TWO SOLDIERS DIE IN CRASH

Camp Atterbury, Aug. 8 (Special)—Lt. Henry B. Malone, 24, and Technician, 4th grade, John W. Hell, 21, were killed near Taggart in Brown county Monday morning when the vehicle in which they were riding turned over.

Lieutenant Malone entered the Army on May 15, 1942, and his home was at 54 Curtiss Place, Maplewood, N. J. He is survived by his wife, who has been living in Franklin.

Technician Hell, whose home was in Carrolltown, Ill., was inducted into the Army on March 11, 1944. His wife and child have been living at Greenwood, Ind.

Both men were members of the 106th Division Reconnaissance troops.

A board of officers has been appointed to investigate the accident.
