

CUBS WIN FIRST TOURNEY TILT

**Van Mungo Fans 17, Allows
Only Two Hits as 106th
Blanks Eastern Nine.**

Led by Van Mungo, former star of the Brooklyn Dodger pitching staff, who struck out 17 batters and allowed only two hits, the 106th Division's Cubs from Camp Atterbury won their first game early Wednesday morning in the national semipro baseball tournament at Wichita, Kans.

The Cubs defeated the Welin-Davit Boat corporation team of Perth Amboy, N. J., New Jersey state champions, 5 to 0, after drawing byes in their first two tourney tilts. The 106th will play again Sunday.

The game with the New Jersey champs started Wednesday night and was played on into the early hours of Thursday morning.
