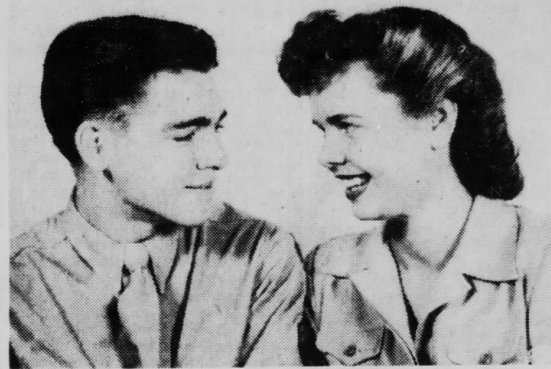


**HONEYMOONING BRIDE WINS TITLE AS CAMP ATTERBURY 'SWEETHEART'**
