Dell of 917 Fifth street received a letter Wednesday from Mrs. Albert Ouellette, reporting that her husband, Major Ouellette, has been missing in action with the 106th since Dec. 18. Major and Mrs. Ouellette and 1½-year-old son, Albert, Jr., resided in the Frall apartments, Fifth street and Lafayette avenue, while Major Ouellette was stationed at Atterbury. Mrs. Ouellette and son are now at West Springfield, Mass.

Sgt. Gordon H. Foster, member of the 106th Division, who resided here with his wife, Mrs. Eleanor Foster, while he was at Atterbury, has been listed as missing in action in Germany since Dec. 17.

Word that he was missing was received at Brandenburger Bros. furniture plant here in a letter from Mrs. Foster, who is now at Glendale, Calif. She was employed in the Brandenburger Bros. office while residing here. Sergeant and Mrs. Foster resided at the S. E. Armstrong residence, 220 Third street. He was serving with the 424th Infantry regiment.

Sgt. Leonard Butterbaugh of the 106th Division field artillery is also missing, according to word from his wife, now at Shelby, Iowa, in a letter to Mrs. Frank Bennett. Sgt. and Mrs. Butterbaugh and three small children lived at the Bennett house last summer.
