

Assignment of Divisions In Europe Made

Nine Divisions Given Occupational Roles— Status of 38 Still

Paris, June 21—(#)—Assignments of twenty-three of the sixty-one American divisions under Gen. Eisenhower's command at the end of the war in Europhave been decided, leaving thirtyeight with their future status unannounced, supreme headquarters said today.

Nine divisions have been given occupational roles. Eleven have been selected for

Two other divisions, the 28th and 29th infantry, had at leas temporary tasks in Europe. The 28th is staffing a German zon which may go to French control later-and the 29th is on duty a port facilities of Bremen, in the British-occupied area, through which American supplies will
