

Tanks Are Moved to Freeman for Training

Tanks are being moved from Camp Atterbury to Freeman Field to be used in training of National Guard units at Freeman Field.

The tanks are being brought on lowboy trucks by the National Guard. One arrived Wednesday and one Thursday and officials hoped to move two additional tanks down today so four would be ready for training Sunday.

The tanks are known as M4A3, commonly known as the General Sherman, equipped with 76 mm cannon. This was a heavy duty tank during World War II and has seen action in Korea.
